## Free Tax Filing Service Available

Chhaya CDC, a community based non-profit organization, is announcing free tax filing services in partnership with the Citizens Committee for New York City. Free tax assistance will be available at Chhaya CDC's office in Jackson Heights **at 37-43 77<sup>th</sup> Street (between Roosevelt and 37<sup>th</sup> Avenues) in Jackson Heights on March 22<sup>nd</sup> from 11 AM-4 PM.**

Those who qualify for this free service are:

- First time tax filers
- People who did not file taxes last year
- People with annual income level of \$40,000 or less (with dependants) and \$20,000 or less for individual filers (without dependants).

ITIN filers are welcome. Community members who wish to apply for an ITIN can also do so on this day. Bi-lingual translation in Bangla, Hindi and Urdu will be available.

**Space is limited and therefore people who are interested in this free service should make an appointment as soon as possible by calling 718-478-3848, ext. 14.** Appointments for earlier dates might be available.
